



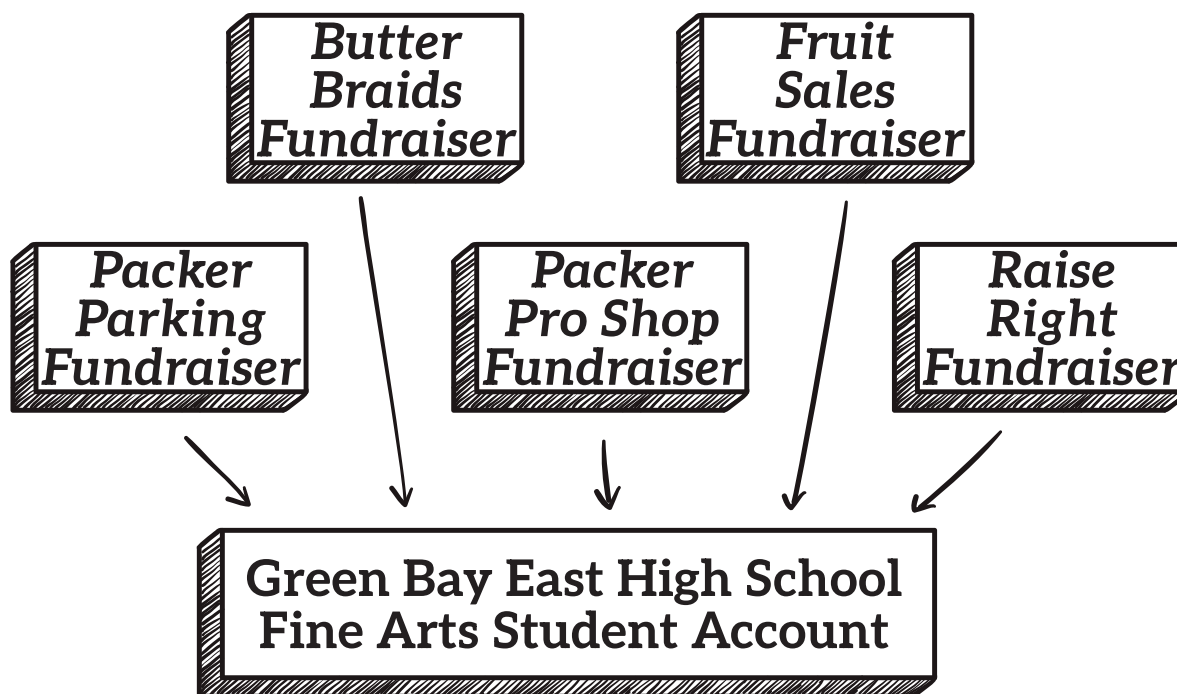
Green Bay East High School Fine Arts Student Accounts

What is the Fine Arts Student Account?

Green Bay East High School allows individual tracking of fundraising efforts in a unique “student account” which follows students throughout their High School career. Students or Parents who participate with certain fundraising projects may earn funds in their “student accounts” which then the student can spend anytime during the school year on faculty approved Fine Arts related expenses. Some examples of faculty approved Fine Arts related items are instrument purchases, instrument repairs, supplies, school trips, and summer workshops.

How can students put money into their account?

Students can earn money from one of the fundraising events held throughout the school year.



What happens to the money that isn't spent after graduation?

Students cannot take the money with them when they leave Green Bay East High School. Each student has the option to gift their unspent to a specific Fine Arts program or Fine Arts Extracurricular (band, choir, theater, show choir, Performance Technology Club, etc).

Can I give my unspent money to a sibling with a Green Bay East High School Fine Arts Student Account?

Yes, students can roll their unspent money into the student account of one of their siblings that has a Green Bay East High School Fine Arts Student Account.
